8 A Concurrent Resolution relating to legislative
9 procedures; establishing a legislative procedure
10 schedule for the 52nd Oklahoma Legislature.

11 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 51ST OKLAHOMA
12 LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:

13 THAT the First Regular Session of the 52nd Oklahoma Legislature
14 shall adhere to the following procedure schedule:

15 1. The First Regular Session of the 52nd Oklahoma Legislature
16 shall convene at twelve noon on January 6, 2009, for the purposes
17 only of performing the duties set forth in Section 5 of Article VI
18 of the Constitution and organizing pursuant to the provisions of
19 Article V of the Constitution, and shall recess no later than five
20 p.m. on that same day until February 2, 2009, beginning at twelve
21 noon.

22 2. December 12, 2008, shall be the final date for requesting
23 the drafting of bills and joint resolutions in the Senate and House

1 of Representatives for introduction for consideration during the
2 First Regular Session.

3 3. January 15, 2009, shall be the final date for introduction
4 of bills and joint resolutions in the Senate and House of
5 Representatives for consideration on the floor of the Senate or
6 House during the First Regular Session. Bills and joint resolutions
7 subsequently introduced if reported from Committee, shall not be
8 placed on the Calendar for consideration in said house until the
9 first legislative day of the Second Regular Session.

10 4. March 12, 2009, shall be the final legislative day for third
11 reading and final passage of a bill or joint resolution in the house
12 of origin.

13 5. April 23, 2009, shall be the final legislative day for third
14 reading and final passage of a bill or joint resolution in the house
15 opposite the house of origin.

16 6. The First Regular Session shall adjourn sine die not later
17 than five p.m. on May 29, 2009.

18 7. Upon a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the membership of both
19 houses, a bill or joint resolution can be exempt from all cutoff
20 dates in both houses.

21 THAT the Second Regular Session of the 52nd Oklahoma Legislature
22 shall adhere to the following procedure schedule:

23 1. December 11, 2009, shall be the final date for requesting
24 the drafting of bills and joint resolutions in the Senate and House

1 of Representatives for introduction for consideration during the
2 Second Regular Session.

3 2. January 14, 2010, shall be the final date for introduction
4 of bills and joint resolutions in the Senate and House of
5 Representatives for consideration on the floor of the Senate or
6 House during the Second Regular Session.

7 3. The Second Regular Session of the 52nd Oklahoma Legislature
8 shall convene at twelve noon on February 1, 2010.

9 4. March 11, 2010, shall be the final legislative day for third
10 reading and final passage of a bill or joint resolution in the house
11 of origin.

12 5. April 22, 2010, shall be the final legislative day for third
13 reading and final passage of a bill or joint resolution in the house
14 opposite the house of origin.

15 6. The Second Regular Session shall adjourn sine die not later
16 than five p.m. on May 28, 2010.

17 7. Upon a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the membership of both
18 houses, a bill or joint resolution can be exempt from all cutoff
19 dates in both houses.

20 THAT this schedule shall be inapplicable to any joint resolution
21 introduced for the purpose of disapproving or approving agency rules
22 pursuant to the provisions of the Administrative Procedures Act.

23 THAT this schedule shall be inapplicable to any bills introduced
24 for the purposes of incorporation and merging different versions of

1 a statute amended in more than one measure at the same or different
2 sessions of the Legislature as set forth in Section 23.1 of Title 75
3 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

4 THAT this schedule shall be inapplicable to any bill or joint
5 resolution introduced for the purpose of approving, disapproving,
6 repealing or modifying rules of the Ethics Commission pursuant to
7 the provisions of Section 3 of Article XXIX of the Oklahoma
8 Constitution.

9 THAT this schedule shall be inapplicable to any bill or joint
10 resolution which proposes a special or local law and for which
11 notice of intended introduction is published in a newspaper for four
12 consecutive weeks pursuant to the provisions of Section 32 of
13 Article V of the Oklahoma Constitution.

14 THAT the dates specified in this resolution for introduction of
15 bills or joint resolutions shall be inapplicable to any bill or
16 joint resolution which contains an "RB" number pursuant to the
17 provisions of the Oklahoma Pension Legislation Actuarial Analysis
18 Act. Such measures shall be submitted to the legislative actuary
19 not later than such dates, and may be introduced not later than the
20 first Monday in February following such submission.
