House Bill No. 2231

HOUSE BILL NO. 2231 - By: MURPHEY of the House and BRANAN of the Senate.

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; amending 69 O.S. 2001, Sections 1229 and 1232, which relate to right-of-way corners; removing requirement for placement of certain markers by the Department of Transportation; modifying application of certain provisions; repealing 69 O.S. 2001, Section 1231, which relates to right-of-way corners; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2001, Section 1229, is amended to read
2 as follows:

3 Section 1229. The Department shall, in cooperation with the county surveyor of the
4 county affected, locate section and quarter section corners within the right-of-way of all
5 state highways when surveys and plans are being made for contemplated new
6 construction or resurfacing, and re-mark such corners in the right-of-way by a suitable
7 marker, of a design to be approved by the Department. ~~Whenever such corners are~~
8 ~~located on a highway to be hard-surfaced, or resurfaced, the Department shall identify~~
9 ~~such corners on the roadway by bronze surface markers, of a design to be approved by~~
10 ~~the Department.~~

11 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2001, Section 1232, is amended to read
12 as follows:

1 Section 1232. The provisions of Sections 1229, and 1230 ~~and 1231~~, shall apply with
2 full force and effect and in like manner to the board of county commissioners of each
3 county in this state, ~~whenever section corners or quarter section corners are obliterated,~~
4 ~~or may be obliterated, by the construction or resurfacing of either low-type or high-type~~
5 ~~paved roads on any county highway within the county.~~

6 SECTION 3. REPEALER 69 O.S. 2001, Section 1231, is hereby repealed.

7 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
