9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to revenue and taxation; amending 68
11 O.S. 2001, Section 106, which relates to examination
and audit of the Tax Commission; modifying methods of
12 distribution of reports; and providing an effective
date.

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15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 68 O.S. 2001, Section 106, is
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 106. The State Auditor and Inspector is hereby
19 authorized and directed to make a continuous examination and audit
20 of the books and accounts of the Tax Commission, making separate
21 reports for each fiscal year ending June 30. Said report shall be
22 distributed, in either printed or electronic form, as follows:

- 23 1. One (1) copy to be filed with the Governor;
24 2. One (1) copy to be filed with the Tax Commission;

1 3. One (1) copy to be filed with the State Budget Director;

2 4. One (1) copy to be filed with the President Pro Tempore of
3 the Senate;

4 5. One (1) copy to be filed with the Speaker of the House of
5 Representatives;

6 6. One (1) copy to be filed with the Legislative Service
7 Bureau; and

8 7. One (1) copy to be retained in the office of the State
9 Auditor and Inspector as a public record.

10 The audit for each fiscal year shall, when possible, be completed by
11 the close of the following fiscal year. It shall also be the duty
12 of the State Auditor and Inspector to make a special audit at any
13 time upon a written request of the Tax Commission or the Governor.
14 The Tax Commission shall furnish the necessary office space for the
15 employees of the State Auditor and Inspector making said audit and,
16 to the extent of the amount included in the Tax Commission's
17 appropriation therefor, the Tax Commission shall pay the expenses of
18 such audits, including personal services, equipment and supplies,
19 from said appropriation. The salaries of the head deputy in charge
20 of such audit, and of his assistants, shall be the same as provided
21 by law for the head deputy State Auditor and Inspector and assistant
22 deputy State Auditors and Inspectors.

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SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 2008.

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
