9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Pardon and Parole Board;  
11 making an appropriation; stating purpose; requiring  
12 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;  
13 requiring performance measures; providing for the  
14 duties and compensation of employees; limiting salary  
15 of the Chief Administrative Officer; providing  
16 budgetary limitations; providing lapse dates;  
17 requiring and prohibiting certain budget practices;  
18 providing an effective date; and declaring an  
19 emergency.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Pardon and  
22 Parole Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
23 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
24 ending June 30, 2009, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00)  
or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed  
upon the Pardon and Parole Board by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the Pardon  
2 and Parole Board shall budget all funds in the following categories  
3 and amounts:

6 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
7 each budget category.

8 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
9 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
10 upon the Pardon and Parole Board by law shall be set by the Chief  
11 Administrative Officer of the Pardon and Parole Board. The salary  
12 of the Chief Administrative Officer of the Pardon and Parole Board  
13 shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable  
14 monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009. The Pardon and  
15 Parole Board for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall be  
16 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-  
17 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for  
18 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant  
19 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma  
20 Statutes:

1       SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including  
2 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for  
3 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 (hereafter FY-09) or may be  
4 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10).  
5 Funds budgeted for FY-09 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
6 2009, and must be expended by November 15, 2009. Any funds  
7 remaining after November 15, 2009, and not budgeted for FY-10, shall  
8 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal  
9 year. Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June  
10 30, 2010. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2010, shall lapse  
11 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
12 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
13 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-09, and not required to pay  
14 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-10, after  
15 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
16 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
17 from the FY-09 budget work program and after such revision has been  
18 approved by the Office of State Finance.

19       SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

20       SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
21 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
