9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the State Auditor and Inspector;  
11 making appropriations; stating purposes; making an  
12 appropriation to the Rural Economic Action Plan Fund;  
13 stating purpose; providing that certain  
14 appropriations shall not be transferable; requiring  
15 budgeting in certain categories and amounts;  
16 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
17 providing budgetary limitations; making certain  
18 appropriations nonfiscal; providing lapse dates;  
19 requiring certain budget procedures; prohibiting  
20 certain budget procedures; providing an effective  
21 date; and declaring an emergency.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the  
24 State Auditor and Inspector from any monies not otherwise  
appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for  
the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars  
(\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties  
imposed upon the State Auditor and Inspector by law.

1 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the  
2 State Auditor and Inspector from any monies not otherwise  
3 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for  
4 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars  
5 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties  
6 imposed upon the Commission on County Government Personnel Education  
7 and Training. The appropriation made in this section shall be  
8 expended exclusively for the purpose so stated and shall not be  
9 transferable.

10 SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Rural Economic  
11 Action Plan Fund of the State Treasury from any monies not otherwise  
12 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for  
13 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars  
14 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to implement the  
15 provisions of Sections 2006 through 2013 of Title 62 of the Oklahoma  
16 Statutes.

17 SECTION 4. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the State  
18 Auditor and Inspector shall budget all funds in the following  
19 categories and amounts:

3 SECTION 5. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
4 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
5 upon the State Auditor and Inspector by law shall be set by the  
6 State Auditor and Inspector. The State Auditor and Inspector for  
7 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the  
8 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees  
9 and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special  
10 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of  
11 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

15 SECTION 6. Appropriations made by this act, not including  
16 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for  
17 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 (hereafter FY-09) or may be  
18 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10).  
19 Funds budgeted for FY-09 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
20 2009, and must be expended by November 15, 2009. Any funds  
21 remaining after November 15, 2009, and not budgeted for FY-10, shall  
22 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal  
23 year. Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June  
24 30, 2010. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2010, shall lapse

1 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
2 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
3 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-09, and not required to pay  
4 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-10, after  
5 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
6 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
7 from the FY-09 budget work program and after such revision has been  
8 approved by the Office of State Finance.

9 SECTION 7. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

10 SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
11 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
