9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Horse Racing
11 Commission; making an appropriation; stating purpose;
12 requiring certain funds to be budgeted in certain
13 categories and amounts; providing for duties and
14 compensation of employees; limiting the salary of the
15 Director; providing budgetary limitations; providing
16 an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 OKLAHOMA HORSE RACING COMMISSION

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Horse
20 Racing Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from
21 the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
22 ending June 30, 2009, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much
23 thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the
24 Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission by law.

1 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
 2 Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission shall budget all funds in the
 3 following categories and amounts:

10 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
 11 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
 12 upon the Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission by law shall be set by the
 13 Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed _____
 14 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year
 15 ending June 30, 2009. The Oklahoma Horse Racing Commission, for the
 16 fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the following
 17 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and
 18 expenditures, excluding expenditures from the Oklahoma Breeding
 19 Development Revolving Fund, except as may be authorized pursuant to
 20 the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

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1 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including
2 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
3 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 (hereafter FY-09) or may be
4 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10).
5 Funds budgeted for FY-09 may be encumbered only through June 30,
6 2009, and must be expended by November 15, 2009. Any funds
7 remaining after November 15, 2009, and not budgeted for FY-10, shall
8 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
9 year. Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June
10 30, 2010. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2010, shall lapse
11 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
12 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
13 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-09, and not required to pay
14 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-10, after
15 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
16 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
17 from the FY-09 budget work program and after such revision has been
18 approved by the Office of State Finance.

19 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

20 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
21 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
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1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
