COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 2602 - By: WESSELHOFT of the House and SYKES of the Senate.

An Act relating to crimes and punishments; making certain acts unlawful; providing penalty; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
2 Statutes as Section 1960 of Title 21, unless there is created a duplication in numbering,
3 reads as follows:

4 A. It shall be unlawful for any sex offender, who is required by law to register
5 pursuant to the Sex Offenders Registration Act, to access or use any Internet social
6 networking web site that allows the sex offender to have contact with any child who is
7 under the age of eighteen (18) years.

8 B. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction, be
9 guilty of a felony.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
