HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 1093 - By: MCAFFREY of the House.

A Joint Resolution memorializing the United States Department of Defense and the United States Department of Labor to include the State of Oklahoma in the Military Spouse Career Advancement Initiative program; and directing for distribution.

1 WHEREAS, Oklahoma citizens play a critical role in the United States military and
2 a large number of Oklahoma's citizens are directly or indirectly involved in the military;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, the United States Department of Defense and the United States
5 Department of Labor have established the Military Spouse Career Advancement
6 Initiative program which provides educational assistance to the spouses of active duty
7 service members in a limited number of states; and

8 WHEREAS, Oklahoma active duty members and their spouses deserve recognition
9 for the sacrifices that they make on a daily basis in defense of this country; and

10 WHEREAS, Oklahoma military members and their spouses should be afforded the
11 full benefit of federal programs available to other service members.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
2 REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 51ST
3 OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

4 SECTION 1. The Oklahoma Legislature memorializes the United States
5 Department of Defense and the United States Department of Labor to include Oklahoma
6 in the Military Spouse Career Advancement Initiative.

7 SECTION 2. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to distribute copies of this
8 resolution to the Governor of Oklahoma, the Secretary of the Department of Defense, and
9 the Secretary of the United States Department of Labor.
