15 may receive thorough consideration; and

16 WHEREAS, the availability of computer technology can improve
17 access to information that is useful during deliberations by
18 subcommittees and full committees; and

19 WHEREAS, it is desirable for the Oklahoma legislative process to
20 meet or exceed modern standards for the flow of information and the
21 use of computer technology is conducive to improving the process by
22 which legislation is considered, debated, modified and acted upon.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
2 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 51ST OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

3 THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives should undertake to
4 modernize its consideration of all legislation during the
5 subcommittee and full committee hearing process using available
6 resources and technology with the goal of improving access to
7 information and improving the efficiency of the legislative process.

10 members of the staff.
