Senate Bill No. 1155

COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 1155 - By: BASS of the Senate and ARMES, DORMAN AND SHANNON of the House.

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating certain highways and bridges; requiring placement of markers; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
2 Statutes as Section 1698.18 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in
3 numbering, reads as follows:

4 The section of State Highway 115 between the junctions of State Highway 49 and
5 State Highway 19 in Comanche and Kiowa Counties shall be designated the “Duty Rowe
6 Scenic Route 115”. The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable markers to be
7 placed upon that section of highway bearing that name.

8 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
9 Statutes as Section 1698.19 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in
10 numbering, reads as follows:

1 The four new bridges on State Highway 32 west of the City of Marietta in Love
2 County crossing the Walnut Bayou shall be designated as the “John Adams and Arlie
3 Harrill Memorial Bridges”. The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
4 permanent markers to be placed upon those bridges bearing those names.

5 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
6 Statutes as Section 1698.20 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in
7 numbering, reads as follows:

8 The bridge on State Highway 62 south of Haskell, Oklahoma, shall be designated
9 the “Private First Class Cody Montana Carver, U.S. Army 3rd Infantry Division
10 Memorial Bridge”. The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
11 markers to be placed upon the bridge bearing that name.

12 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
13 Statutes as Section 1698.21 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in
14 numbering, reads as follows:

15 The section of State Highway 64 between Muskogee and Keefeton shall be
16 designated the “Representative Jim L. Barker, Speaker of the Oklahoma House of
17 Representatives Memorial Highway”. The Department of Transportation shall cause
18 suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

19 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
20 Statutes as Section 1698.22 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in
21 numbering, reads as follows:

1 The section of State Highway 9 from Skagg City Road east to the intersection of
2 State Highway 9-A in Pottawatomie County shall be designated the “U.S. Army Staff
3 Sergeant Ruben Rivers Highway”. SSG Ruben Rivers was killed in action during World
4 War II on November 19, 1944. He was posthumously awarded the Medal of Honor for his
5 heroic efforts as a member of the 761st Tank Battalion, the first African-American
6 armored unit to serve in combat. In addition to the Medal of Honor, Staff Sergeant
7 Rivers was awarded the Silver Star for previous action with his battalion. The
8 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable markers to be placed upon that
9 section of highway bearing that name.

10 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
11 Statutes as Section 1698.23 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in
12 numbering, reads as follows:

13 The section of Interstate 35 from State Highway 64 (Fir Street) south to State
14 Highway 51 shall be designated the “SPC Ross Hunter Duncan Memorial Highway”. The
15 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on
16 the highway bearing the name.

17 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma
18 Statutes as Section 1698.24 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in
19 numbering, reads as follows:

20 The section of State Highway 105 from I-35 east to the Lincoln County line shall be
21 designated the “OHP Lt. J.C. Burris Memorial Highway”. The Department of

1 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway
2 bearing the name.

3 SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
4 peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof
5 this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
