13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Commissioners of
15 the Land Office from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
16 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
17 ending June 30, 2009, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00)
18 or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
19 upon the Commissioners of the Land Office by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
21 Commissioners of the Land Office shall budget all funds in the
22 following categories and amounts:

5 The Department shall develop outcome-based performance measures
6 for each budget category.

7 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
8 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
9 upon the Department of the Commissioners of the Land Office by law
10 shall be set by the Secretary of the Department. The salary of the
11 Secretary shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per
12 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.
13 The salary of the Assistant Secretary shall not exceed ninety
14 percent (90%) of the Secretary's salary per annum, payable monthly
15 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009. The Department of the
16 Commissioners of the Land Office for the fiscal year ending June 30,
17 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on
18 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding
19 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be
20 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
21 the Oklahoma Statutes:
