13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
15 Commissioners of the Land Office shall budget all funds in the
16 following categories and amounts:

23 The Department shall develop outcome-based performance measures
24 for each budget category.

1 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
2 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
3 upon the Department of the Commissioners of the Land Office by law
4 shall be set by the Secretary of the Department. The salary of the
5 Secretary shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per
6 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.
7 The salary of the Assistant Secretary shall not exceed ninety
8 percent (90%) of the Secretary's salary per annum, payable monthly
9 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009. The Department of the
10 Commissioners of the Land Office for the fiscal year ending June 30,
11 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on
12 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding
13 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be
14 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
15 the Oklahoma Statutes:
