12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Auditor
14 and Inspector from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
15 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
16 ending June 30, 2009, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or
17 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
18 upon the State Auditor and Inspector by law.

19 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the State
20 Auditor and Inspector shall budget all funds in the following
21 categories and amounts:

8 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
9 each budget category.

10 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
11 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
12 upon the State Auditor and Inspector by law shall be set by the
13 State Auditor and Inspector. The State Auditor and Inspector for
14 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the
15 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees
16 and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
17 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
18 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
