12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the State
14 Election Board shall budget all funds in the following categories
15 and amounts:

1 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
2 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
3 upon the State Election Board by law shall be set by the Secretary
4 of the State Election Board. The salary of the Secretary of the
5 State Election Board shall not exceed _____
6 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year
7 ending June 30, 2009. The State Election Board for the fiscal year
8 ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary
9 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures
10 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as
11 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
12 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
