12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
14 Department of Labor shall budget all funds in the following
15 categories and amounts:

3 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
4 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed

6 of Labor. The Department of Labor for the fiscal year ending June
7 30, 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on
8 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding
9 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be
10 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
11 the Oklahoma Statutes:
