13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of
15 Mines from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General
16 Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June
17 30, 2009, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof
18 as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the
19 Department of Mines by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
21 Department of Mines shall budget all funds in the following
22 categories and amounts:

7 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
8 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
9 upon the Department of Mines by law shall be set by the Executive
10 Director of the Department of Mines. The salary of the Executive
11 Director of the Department of Mines shall not exceed _____
12 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year
13 ending June 30, 2009. The Department of Mines for the fiscal year
14 ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary
15 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures
16 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as
17 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
18 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
