13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the  
15 Department of Mines shall budget all funds in the following  
16 categories and amounts:

23 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for

1 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
2 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
3 upon the Department of Mines by law shall be set by the Executive  
4 Director of the Department of Mines. The salary of the Executive  
5 Director of the Department of Mines shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_  
6 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year  
7 ending June 30, 2009. The Department of Mines for the fiscal year  
8 ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary  
9 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures  
10 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as  
11 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of  
12 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
