12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. The Supreme Court is hereby authorized to expend  
14 during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, from the State Judicial  
15 Revolving Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_  
16 Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the  
17 financial support of the district courts.

18 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the  
19 Supreme Court shall budget all funds appropriated or otherwise made  
20 available for the operation of the district courts in the following  
21 categories and amounts:
