11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
13 Supreme Court shall budget all funds appropriated or otherwise made
14 available for the operation of the district courts in the following
15 categories and amounts:

18 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the annual
19 compensation of the following employees of the district courts
