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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the Board
15 of Medicolegal Investigations shall budget all funds in the
16 following categories and amounts:

21 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for

23 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
24 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed

1 upon the Board of Medicolegal Investigations by law shall be set by
2 the Board. The salary of the Chief Medical Examiner shall not
3 exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for
4 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009. The Board of Medicolegal
5 Investigations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall be
6 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-
7 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for
8 capital, intra-agency payments and special projects, except as may
9 be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74
10 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
