ENGROSSED SENATE BILL NO. 1992 - By: NICHOLS of the Senate and TERRILL of the House.

[child stealing - purpose and intent -
effective date]

1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 891, as amended by
2 Section 10, Chapter 261, O.S.L. 2007 (21 O.S. Supp. 2007, Section 891), is amended to
3 read as follows:
4 Section 891. Whoever maliciously, forcibly or fraudulently takes or entices away
5 any child under the age of sixteen (16) years, with intent to detain ~~and~~ or conceal such
6 child from its parent, guardian or other person having the lawful charge of such child or
7 to transport such child from the jurisdiction of this state or the United States without the
8 consent of the person having lawful charge of such child shall, upon conviction, be guilty
9 of a felony punishable by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections
10 not exceeding ten (10) years.
11 Except for persons sentenced to life or life without parole, any person sentenced to
12 imprisonment for two (2) years or more for a violation of this section and the offense

1 involved sexual abuse or sexual exploitation, shall be required to serve a term of post-
2 imprisonment supervision pursuant to subparagraph f of paragraph 1 of subsection A of
3 Section 991a of Title 22 of the Oklahoma Statutes under conditions determined by the
4 Department of Corrections. The jury shall be advised that the mandatory post-
5 imprisonment supervision shall be in addition to the actual imprisonment.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
