8 A Concurrent Resolution declaring February 6, 2008,  
9 "Ronald Reagan Day" in the State of Oklahoma; urging  
10 all citizens to take cognizance of this event and  
11 participate in its observance; and directing  
12 distribution.

13 WHEREAS, President Ronald Wilson Reagan, a man of humble  
14 background, worked throughout his life serving freedom and advancing  
15 the public good, having been employed as an entertainer, union  
16 leader, corporate spokesman, Governor of California, and President  
17 of the United States;

18 WHEREAS, Ronald Reagan served with honor and distinction for two  
19 terms as the fortieth President of the United States of America, the  
20 second of which earned him the confidence of three-fifths of the  
21 electorate and victory in forty-nine of the fifty states in the  
22 general election – a record unsurpassed in the history of American  
23 presidential elections; and

1       WHEREAS, in 1981, when Ronald Reagan was inaugurated President,  
2 he inherited a disillusioned nation shackled by rampant inflation  
3 and high unemployment; and

4       WHEREAS, during Mr. Reagan's presidency he worked in a  
5 bipartisan manner to enact his bold agenda of restoring  
6 accountability and common sense to government which led to an  
7 unprecedented economic expansion and opportunity for millions of  
8 Americans; and

9       WHEREAS, President Reagan's commitment to an active social  
10 policy agenda for the nation's children helped lower crime and drug  
11 use in our neighborhoods; and

12       WHEREAS, President Reagan's commitment to our armed forces  
13 contributed to the restoration of pride in America, her values and  
14 those cherished by the free world, and prepared American's armed  
15 forces to meet twenty-first century challenges; and

16       WHEREAS, President Reagan's vision of "peace through strength"  
17 led to the end of the Cold War and the ultimate demise of the Soviet  
18 Union, guaranteeing basic human rights for millions of people; and

19       WHEREAS, February 6, 2008, will be the 97th anniversary of  
20 Ronald Reagan's birth, and the third since his passing.

21       NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION  
22 OF THE 51ST OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
