9 High School Bluejays Boys Basketball Team for winning
10 the 2008 Class 5A State Championship; commending
11 their record; and directing distribution.

12 WHEREAS, the 2007-2008 Guthrie High School Bluejays Boys
13 Basketball Team, with a record of 22-4, won the 2008 Class 5A State
14 Championship, the school's sixth and the first in 39 years; and

15 WHEREAS, the 2007-2008 Guthrie High School Bluejays Boys
16 Basketball Team demonstrated collective coolness under pressure as
17 they won a number of close games in the last seconds, including a
18 50-48 victory over Tulsa Edison, to advance to the Class 5A
19 Championship game where they prevailed over Tulsa's Booker T.

22 triumphed in a 75-73 double-overtime victory over Stillwater; and
