8 [motor vehicles - creating ten-year tag option for antique
9 or classic cars - effective date]

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 10, Chapter 504, O.S.L.
12 2004 (47 O.S. Supp. 2006, Section 1135.1), is amended to read as
13 follows:

14 Section 1135.1 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
15 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
16 plates to persons as provided by this section.

17 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
18 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
19 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
20 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
21 registered for the current year.

22 ~~Special~~ Except as provided in subsection B of this section,
23 special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
24 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall

1 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
2 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
3 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
4 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
5 issued on a staggered system. The motor license agent fees shall be
6 paid out of the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

7 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
8 follows:

9 1. Political Subdivision Plates - such plates shall be designed
10 for any vehicle owned by any political subdivision of this state
11 having obtained a proper Oklahoma certificate of title. Such
12 political subdivisions shall file an annual report with the Tax
13 Commission stating the agency where such vehicle is located. Such
14 license plates shall be permanent in nature and designed in such a
15 manner as to remain with the vehicle for the duration of the life
16 span of the vehicle or until the title is transferred to an owner
17 who is not a political subdivision.

18 The registration fee shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be
19 in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except
20 the registration fees levied by Section 1132 of Title 47 of the
21 Oklahoma Statutes;

22 2. Tax-Exempt or Nonprofit License Plates - such plates shall
23 be designed for:

- 1 a. any motor bus, manufactured home, or mobile chapel and
2 power unit owned and operated by a religious
3 corporation or society of this state holding a valid
4 exemption from taxation issued pursuant to Section
5 501(a) of the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C.,
6 Section 501(a), and listed as an exempt organization
7 in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as
8 amended, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), and that is
9 used by the corporation or society solely for the
10 furtherance of its religious functions,
11 b. any vehicle owned and operated only by nonprofit
12 organizations devoted exclusively to youth programs
13 including, but not limited to, the Girl Scouts and Boy
14 Scouts of America,
15 c. any vehicle, except passenger automobiles, owned or
16 operated by nonprofit organizations actually involved
17 in programs for the employment of the handicapped and
18 used exclusively in the transportation of goods or
19 materials for such organization,
20 d. any vehicle owned and operated by a nonprofit
21 organization that provides older persons
22 transportation to and from medical, dental and

1 religious services and relief from business and social
2 isolation,
3 e. any vehicle owned and operated by a private nonprofit
4 organization that:
5 (1) warehouses and distributes surplus foods to other
6 nonprofit agencies and organizations, and
7 (2) holds a valid exemption from taxation issued
8 pursuant to Section 501(c) of the Internal
9 Revenue Code, as amended, 26 U.S.C., Section
10 501(c), and listed as an exempt organization in
11 Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code,
12 as amended, and
13 (3) uses such vehicle exclusively for the
14 transportation of such surplus foods, or
15 f. any vehicle which:
16 (1) is owned and operated by a private, nonprofit
17 organization which is exempt from taxation
18 pursuant to the provisions of Section 501(c)(3)
19 of the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section
20 501(c)(3), and which is primarily funded by a
21 fraternal or civic service organization with at
22 least one hundred local chapters or clubs, and

1 (2) is designed and used to provide mobile health
2 screening services to the general public at no
3 cost to the recipient, and for which no
4 reimbursement of any kind is received from any
5 health insurance provider, health maintenance
6 organization or governmental program.

7 Any person claiming to be eligible for a tax-exempt or nonprofit
8 license plate under the provisions of this paragraph must have the
9 name of the tax-exempt or nonprofit organization prominently
10 displayed upon the outside of the vehicle, except those vehicles
11 registered pursuant to the provisions of subparagraph b of this
12 paragraph, unless such display is prohibited by federal or state law
13 or by state agency rules. No vehicle shall be licensed as a tax-
14 exempt or nonprofit vehicle unless the vehicle has affixed on each
15 side thereof, in letters not less than two (2) inches high and two
16 (2) inches wide, the name of the tax-exempt or nonprofit
17 organization or the insignia or other symbol of such organization
18 which shall be of sufficient size, shape and color as to be readily
19 legible during daylight hours from a distance of fifty (50) feet
20 while the vehicle is not in motion.

21 The registration fee shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be
22 in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except
23 the registration fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

1 3. Physically Disabled License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed for persons who are eligible for an insignia as a
3 physically disabled person under the provisions of Section 15-112 of
4 this title. It shall prominently display the international
5 accessibility symbol, which is a stylized human figure in a
6 wheelchair. The Tax Commission shall also design physically
7 disabled license plates for motorcycles owned by persons who are
8 eligible for an insignia as a physically disabled person pursuant to
9 the provisions of Section 15-112 of this title. Upon the death of
10 the physically disabled person, the special license plate shall be
11 returned to the Tax Commission. There shall be no fee for such
12 plate in addition to the rate provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle
13 License and Registration Act for the registration of the vehicle.
14 For an additional fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00), a person eligible for
15 a physically disabled license plate shall have the option of
16 purchasing a duplicate physically disabled special license plate
17 which shall be securely attached to the front of the vehicle. The
18 original physically disabled special license plate shall be securely
19 attached to the rear of the vehicle at all times.

20 Any person who is eligible for a physically disabled license
21 plate and whose vehicle has had modifications because of the
22 physical disability of the owner or of a family member within the
23 second degree of consanguinity of the owner, may register the

1 vehicle for a flat fee of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00). This fee
2 shall be in lieu of all other registration fees provided by the
3 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;

4 4. Indian Tribal License Plates - such plates shall be designed
5 for any vehicle of a native American Indian Tribal Association
6 exempted in Sections 201 through 204 of Public Law 97-473 and used
7 by the tribal association exclusively for the furtherance of its
8 tribal functions.

9 The registration fee shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be
10 in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except
11 the registration fees levied by Section 1132 of this title;

12 5. Hearing Impaired License Plates - such plates shall be
13 designed for persons who are hearing impaired. Such persons may
14 apply for a hearing-impaired license plate for each vehicle with a
15 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon the presentment
16 of an application on a form furnished by the Tax Commission and
17 certified by a physician holding a valid license to practice
18 pursuant to the licensing provisions of Title 59 of the Oklahoma
19 Statutes, attesting that the person is hearing impaired. The
20 license plate shall be designed so that such persons may be readily
21 identified as being hearing impaired. There shall be no additional
22 fee for the plate, but all other registration fees provided by the
23 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act shall apply;

1 6. Antique or Classic vehicles - such plates shall be designed
2 and issued for any vehicle twenty-five (25) years of age or older,
3 based upon the date of manufacture thereof and which travels on the
4 highways of this state primarily incidental to historical or
5 exhibition purposes only.

6 The registration fee shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be
7 in addition to all other registration fees provided by law, except
8 the registration fees levied by Section 1132 of this title. Any
9 person registering an antique or classic vehicle may elect to have
10 the vehicle registered for a ten-year period. The registration fee
11 for the elected ten-year registration shall be Seventy-five Dollars
12 (\$75.00). The motor license agent registering the antique or
13 classic vehicle for a ten-year period shall receive one hundred
14 percent (100%) of the fees the motor license agent would have
15 otherwise received pursuant to subsection A of Section 1141.1 of
16 this title if the antique or classic vehicle had been registered on
17 an annual basis; and

18 7. Honorary Consul License Plate - such plates shall be
19 designed to include the words "Honorary Consul" and issued to
20 persons who are honorary consuls authorized by the United States to
21 perform consular duties. Persons applying for such license plates
22 must show proof of standing as an honorary consul. The fee for such
23 plate shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be in addition to all

1 other registration fees required by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
2 Registration Act. The owner of the vehicle that possesses such
3 license plates shall return the special license plates to the
4 Oklahoma Tax Commission if the owner disposes of the vehicle during
5 the registration year or ceases to be authorized to perform consular
6 duties.

7 C. Special license plates provided by this section shall be
8 designed in such a manner as to identify the use or ownership of the
9 vehicle. Use of any vehicle possessing a special license plate
10 provided by this section for any purpose not specified herein shall
11 be grounds for revocation of the special license plate and
12 registration certificate.

13 D. The fees provided by this section shall be deposited in the
14 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

15 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 14, Chapter 504, O.S.L.
16 2004, as last amended by Section 25, Chapter 44, 2nd Extraordinary
17 Session, O.S.L. 2006 (47 O.S. Supp. 2006, Section 1135.5), is
18 amended to read as follows:

19 Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
20 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
21 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
22 financial assistance as provided by this section.

1 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
2 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
3 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
4 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
5 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

6 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
7 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
8 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
9 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
10 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
11 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
12 issued on a staggered system.

13 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
14 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
15 applications for special license plates authorized under this
16 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
17 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
18 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
19 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
20 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
21 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
22 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for

1 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
2 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

3 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
4 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
5 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
6 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
7 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
8 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
9 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
10 removed from the vehicle.

11 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
12 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
13 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
14 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
15 the Tax Commission within one hundred and eighty (180) days of the
16 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
17 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
18 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
19 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

20 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
21 follows:

22 1. University or College Supporter License Plates - such plates
23 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate

1 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
2 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
3 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

4 2. Environmental Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
5 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
6 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
7 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
8 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide
9 general public environmental education program created pursuant to
10 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
11 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination
12 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
13 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued
14 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
15 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
16 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
17 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
18 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
19 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

20 3. Firefighter License Plates - such plates shall be designed
21 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.
22 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
23 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a

1 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
2 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
3 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
4 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
5 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
6 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
7 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
8 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
9 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
10 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
11 of the fire department.

12 Except for motorcycles, the license plate shall have the legend
13 "Oklahoma" in the color Pantone 186C Red and shall contain no more
14 than three letters and three numbers in the color Pantone 301C Blue.
15 Between the letters and numbers shall be the Firefighter Maltese
16 Cross Logo in the color Pantone 186C Red outlined in the color
17 Pantone 301C Blue. Below the letters and the logo shall be the word
18 "Firefighter" in the color Pantone 186C Red. The license plate for
19 motorcycles may be of a similar design as space permits or a new
20 design in order to meet the space requirements of a motorcycle
21 license plate. The plates shall not be subject to the design
22 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other

1 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
2 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue.

3 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
4 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
5 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighter Fallen and
6 Living Memorial;

7 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
9 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
10 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
11 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
12 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
13 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
14 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
15 plates.

16 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
17 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
18 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

19 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plates - such plates shall be
20 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
21 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
22 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child

1 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
2 the prevention of child abuse.

3 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
4 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

5 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates -
6 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
7 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The
8 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
9 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
10 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States
11 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if
12 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United
13 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be
14 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or
15 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not
16 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
17 issued;

18 7. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
20 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
21 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
22 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

1 8. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother
3 Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
4 shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving
5 Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton,
6 Oklahoma;

7 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
9 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
10 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
11 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
12 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
13 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

14 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates
15 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
16 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
17 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
18 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
19 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in
20 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
21 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
22 collected shall be apportioned to the county of residence of the

1 person purchasing the plates to be equally apportioned by the county
2 to the city and county volunteer fire departments in the county;

3 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
5 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
6 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
7 Revolving Fund;

8 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
9 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
10 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
11 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
12 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
13 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
14 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
15 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
16 provide services to crime victims;

17 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates
18 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
19 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The
20 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
21 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
22 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -

1 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to
2 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

3 14. Four-H Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
4 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the
5 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
6 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued
7 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in
8 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to
9 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
10 Section 1104.4 of this title;

11 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
12 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
13 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
14 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued
15 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag
16 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an
17 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
18 Section 1104.3 of this title;

19 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates
20 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
21 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The
22 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
23 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As

1 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
2 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
3 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
4 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

5 17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be
6 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
7 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
8 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
9 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
10 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
11 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
12 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
13 follows:

- 14 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
15 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 16 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
17 Education Revolving Fund,
- 18 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
19 Career Technology Fund, and
- 20 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
21 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
22 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
23 Oklahoma Statutes.

1 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a
2 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial
3 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be
4 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
5 paragraph;

6 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plates -
7 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of
8 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the
9 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the
10 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as
11 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate
12 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in
13 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
14 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.
15 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
16 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
17 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
18 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
19 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
20 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
21 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
22 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
23 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

1 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plates - such
2 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
3 demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall
4 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters
5 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates.
6 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo.
7 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into
8 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any
9 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts
10 of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
11 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty
12 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

13 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plates - such
14 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
15 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
16 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
17 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
18 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
19 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
20 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
21 of this title;

22 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plates - such plates
23 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax

1 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
2 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
3 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
4 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
5 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
6 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

7 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plates - such plates
8 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of
9 pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for
10 adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive
11 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and
12 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates
13 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation
14 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human
15 Services. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall
16 be deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury
17 for and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the
18 implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act
19 specifically for created families;

20 23. Choose Life License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
21 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life,
22 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of
23 organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women

1 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount
2 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life
3 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of
4 this title;

5 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall
6 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
7 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The
8 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
9 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an
10 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
11 Section 1104.7 of this title;

12 25. Lions Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed
13 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions
14 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
15 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
16 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
17 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation
18 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association
19 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
20 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service
21 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
22 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
23 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

1 26. Color Oklahoma License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
3 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
4 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
5 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's
6 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,
7 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
8 Section 1104.8 of this title;

9 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter
10 License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
11 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the
12 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person
13 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
14 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain
15 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The
16 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
17 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of
18 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use
19 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The
20 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts
21 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout
22 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
23 plate issued;

1 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plates - such
2 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
3 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The
4 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City
5 Memorial Marathon. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
6 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon
7 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
8 Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing
9 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial
10 Marathon of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
11 plate issued;

12 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The
14 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Scenic
15 Rivers Commission. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be
16 apportioned to the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission;

17 30. Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed
18 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry.
19 The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. The
20 American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the
21 American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be
22 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty

1 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma
2 Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund;

3 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
5 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational
6 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in
7 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty
8 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the
9 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet
10 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the
11 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in
12 Section 1104.10 of this title;

13 32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in
14 consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to
15 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who
16 are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active
17 duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination
18 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
19 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion
20 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate
21 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title;

22 33. Armed Forces Veterans Motorcycle License Plate - such
23 plates shall be designed for use on a motorcycle in consultation

1 with A Brotherhood Aiming Toward Education of Oklahoma, Inc.
2 (ABATE), and issued to any honorably discharged former member of the
3 United States Armed Forces wishing to demonstrate support for the
4 45th Infantry Division Museum. Persons applying for such license
5 plate must show proof of past military service. As provided in this
6 section, a portion of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
7 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in Section 235.1 of Title
8 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

9 34. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be
10 designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma
11 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma
12 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States
13 or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on
14 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any
15 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As
16 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be
17 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in
18 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

19 35. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plates -
20 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
21 demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of America. The
22 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
23 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized

1 license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boys and Girls
2 Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter
3 into a licensing agreement with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America
4 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
5 Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design. The licensing
6 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and Girls Clubs of
7 America of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
8 plate issued;

9 36. Oklahoma Quarter Horse License Plates - such plates shall
10 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
11 for the American Quarter Horse in Oklahoma. The plate shall be
12 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Quarter Horse
13 Association. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee
14 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Revolving
15 Fund created in Section ~~3 of Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1074 of the~~
16 ~~2nd Session of the 50th Oklahoma Legislature~~ 1104.12 of this title;

17 37. Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License Plate - such
18 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
19 Association for the Deaf and issued to any person wishing to
20 demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are deaf. The plates
21 shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and
22 letters from one to maximum of seven, as for personalized license
23 plates. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected

1 shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License
2 Plate Revolving Fund created in Section ~~22 of Enrolled House Bill~~
3 ~~No. 2708 of the 2nd Session of the 50th Oklahoma Legislature~~ 1104.15
4 of this title;

5 38. Oklahoma City Zoo License Plate - such plates shall be
6 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
7 City Zoo. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
8 the Oklahoma Zoological Society, Inc. As provided in this section,
9 an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma
10 Zoological Society Revolving Fund created in Section ~~4 of Enrolled~~
11 ~~Senate Bill No. 1412 of the 2nd Session of the 50th Oklahoma~~
12 ~~Legislature~~ 1104.13 of this title;

13 39. March of Dimes License Plate - such plates shall be issued
14 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the March of Dimes
15 mission to improve the health of babies by preventing birth defects,
16 premature birth and infant mortality. The license plates shall be
17 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter March of Dimes.
18 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
19 deposited in the Oklahoma Prevent Birth Defects, Premature Birth and
20 Infant Mortality Fund established in Section ~~5 of Enrolled Senate~~
21 ~~Bill No. 1412 of the 2nd Session of the 50th Oklahoma Legislature~~
22 1104.14 of this title; and

1 40. Support Our Troops Supporter License Plates - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
3 support for Support Our Troops Incorporated. The plates shall be
4 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
5 one to a maximum of six. The plate shall contain the official
6 Support Our Troops Incorporated logo which includes the mark
7 "Support Our Troops" across the bottom of the plate. The Tax
8 Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with
9 Support Our Troops Incorporated for any licensing fees which may be
10 required in order to use the Support Our Troops Incorporated logo or
11 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
12 Support Our Troops Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for
13 each license plate issued; and

14 41. Oklahoma Realtors License Plates - such plates shall be
15 designed and issued to any member of the Oklahoma Association of
16 Realtors. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
17 the Oklahoma Association of Realtors. As provided in this section,
18 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be **deposited in**
19 **the Oklahoma Housing Foundation Fund established in Section 2 of**
20 **this act.**

21 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
22 (\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees

1 provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. The
2 fee shall be apportioned as follows:

3 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) or any other amount as provided in
4 this title of the fee shall be apportioned as provided or deposited
5 in a fund or to an entity as specified within the paragraph
6 authorizing the special license plate;

7 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the fee shall be deposited in the
8 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the
9 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;
10 and

11 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
12 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

13 **SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified**
14 **in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104.16 of Title 47, unless**
15 **there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:**

16 A. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee authorized by Section
17 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes for the Oklahoma
18 Realtors license plate shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Housing
19 Foundation Fund established in subsection B of this section.

20 B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
21 fund to be designated the "Oklahoma Housing Foundation Fund" and
22 administered by the Oklahoma Real Estate Commission. The fund shall
23 be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and

1 shall consist of all the monies received by the Commission pursuant
2 to the provisions of Section 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma
3 Statutes. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are
4 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Commission at
5 the beginning of each fiscal year for the purpose of providing funds
6 to the Oklahoma Housing Foundation, an Oklahoma not-for-profit
7 corporation, organized to promote the availability of affordable,
8 adequate, safe, and decent housing to the citizens of Oklahoma;
9 support education and research in housing issues, problems, and
10 opportunities; provide technical assistance to groups seeking to
11 deal with housing issues and needs; and engage in activities
12 intended to enhance the ability of Oklahoma citizens to secure
13 housing. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants
14 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
15 law with the Director of State Finance for approval and payment.

16 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective November 1, 2007.
