ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 2691 - By: Roan, Blackwell, Hilliard, Lamons, Luttrell, Rousselot, Banz, Brannon, Brown, Glenn, Hoskin, Hyman, Jackson, Kiesel, Murphey, Renegar, Sears, Shoemake, Shumate, Smithson, Walker and Wesselhoft of the House and Gumm, Myers and Sweeden of the Senate.

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating portion of U.S. Highway 177 as the Staff Sergeant Billy M. Castleberry Memorial Highway; providing for placement of permanent markers; designating certain bridge on State Highway 31 as the PFC Glen W. Page Memorial Bridge; providing for placement of permanent markers; designating certain bridge on State Highway 31 as the Pvt. Everett C. (Bud) Ward Memorial Bridge; providing for placement of permanent markers; designating certain bridge on State Highway 97 as the OHP Lt. Pat Grimes Memorial Bridge; providing for placement of permanent markers; designating certain bridge on U.S. Highway 60 as the P.O.W./M.I.A. Memorial Bridge; providing for placement of permanent markers; designating certain bridge on State Highway 7 as the PFC Danny Leo Evans Memorial Bridge; providing for placement of permanent markers; designating certain bridge on State Highway 7 as the SPC4 Benny Joe Lewis Memorial Bridge; providing for placement of permanent markers; designating a section of State Highway 251A as the Kelly Downing Memorial Highway; providing for placement of permanent markers; designating a section of U.S. Highway 83 as the Oklahoma Panhandle Vietnam Veterans Memorial Highway; providing for placement of permanent markers; designating certain bridge on U.S. Highway 77 as the Cpl. Bryan J. Scripsick Memorial Bridge; providing for placement of permanent markers; designating a section of U.S. Highway 69 as the Veterans Memorial Highway; providing for placement of permanent markers; designating a section of Interstate 35 as the A.C. Hamlin Parkway; providing for placement of permanent markers; designating a section of State Highway 3 as the SGT Jonathan Paul Dragus Memorial Highway; providing for placement of permanent markers; designating certain

1 bridge as the Ronald Glenn Bridge; providing for placement
2 of permanent markers; providing for codification; and
3 declaring an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

5 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.18 of Title 69, unless
7 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 U.S. Highway 177, where it passes through Johnston County, shall
9 be designated as the "Staff Sergeant Billy M. Castleberry Memorial
10 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
11 permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

12 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.19 of Title 69, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The bridge across Salt Creek, currently known as the "salt
16 creek" bridge, located on State Highway 31 south of Ashland,
17 Oklahoma, shall be designated as the "PFC Glen W. Page Memorial
18 Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
19 permanent markers to be placed upon the bridge bearing that name.

20 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.20 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The bridge located where State Highway 31 crosses Keel Creek
24 northeast of Coalgate, Oklahoma, and near Cairo, Oklahoma, shall be

1 designated as the "Pvt. Everett C. (Bud) Ward Memorial Bridge". The
2 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
3 to be placed upon the bridge bearing that name.

4 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.21 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The bridge located where State Highway 97 crosses the Arkansas
8 River in Sand Springs, Oklahoma, shall be designated as the "OHP Lt.
9 Pat Grimes Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall
10 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the bridge
11 bearing that name.

12 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.22 of Title 69, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The bridge located where U.S. Highway 60 crosses the Arkansas
16 River in Ponca City, Oklahoma, shall be designated as the
17 "P.O.W./M.I.A. Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation
18 shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the bridge
19 bearing that name.

20 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.23 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The bridge located where State Highway 7 crosses the western
2 portion of Clear Boggy Creek in Atoka County shall be designated as
3 the "PFC Danny Leo Evans Memorial Bridge". The Department of
4 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
5 upon the bridge bearing that name.

6 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.24 of Title 69, unless
8 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 The bridge located where State Highway 7 crosses the eastern
10 portion of Clear Boggy Creek in Atoka County shall be designated as
11 the "SPC4 Benny Joe Lewis Memorial Bridge". The Department of
12 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
13 upon the bridge bearing that name.

14 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.25 of Title 69, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The section of State Highway 251A in Wagoner County extending
18 from the junction of State Highway 251A and State Highway 16 east to
19 Cherokee County shall be designated as the "Kelly Downing Memorial
20 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
21 permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

1 SECTION 9. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.26 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The section of U.S. Highway 83 in Beaver County extending from
5 the Kansas state line to the Texas state line shall be designated as
6 the "Oklahoma Panhandle Vietnam Veterans Memorial Highway". The
7 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
8 to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

9 SECTION 10. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.27 of Title 69, unless
11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 The "Washita River Bridge" located on U.S. Highway 77 in Garvin
13 County shall be known as the "Cpl. Bryan J. Scripsick Memorial
14 Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
15 permanent markers to be placed upon the bridge bearing that name.

16 SECTION 11. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.28 of Title 69, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 U.S. Highway 69 from South 760 county road extending north to
20 South 690 county road in Wagoner County shall be designated as
21 "Veterans Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
22 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing
23 that name.

1 SECTION 12. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.29 of Title 69, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The section of Interstate 35 extending from Waterloo Road to
5 Charter Oak Road shall be designated as the "A.C. Hamlin Parkway".
6 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
7 markers to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

8 SECTION 13. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
9 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.30 of Title 69, unless
10 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

11 The section of State Highway 3 extending from Interstate 44 to
12 Pennsylvania Avenue in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma shall be designated
13 as the "SGT Jonathan Paul Dragus Memorial Highway". The Department
14 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be
15 placed on the highway bearing that name.

16 SECTION 14. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.31 of Title 69, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 The "Cedar Creek Bridge" which is located approximately 4 miles
20 south of Hodgen, Oklahoma on State Highway 59 in Le Flore County
21 shall be known as the "Ronald Glenn Bridge". The Department of
22 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
23 upon the bridge bearing that name.

1 SECTION 15. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
