SENATE BILL NO. 1663 - By: SYKES of the Senate and REYNOLDS of the House.

[crimes and punishments - destruction of property - effective date]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1760, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1760. A. Every person who maliciously injures, defaces or destroys any real or personal property not his or her own, in cases other than such as are specified in Section 1761 et seq. of this title, is guilty of:

1. A misdemeanor, if the damage, defacement or destruction causes a loss which ~~is valued at~~ has an aggregate value of less than Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00); or

2. A felony, if the damage, defacement or destruction causes a loss which ~~is valued at~~ has an aggregate value of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) or more.

B. In addition to any other punishment prescribed by law for violations of subsection A of this section, he or she is liable in treble damages for the injury done, to be recovered in a civil

2 thereof.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
