5 SENATE BILL NO. 1672 - By: CORN of the Senate and DUNCAN of the

7 [ crimes and punishments - criminalizing use of certain  
8 devices - codification - effective date -  
9 emergency ]

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1272.3 of Title 21, unless there  
13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 It is unlawful for any person to knowingly discharge, or cause  
15 to be discharged, any electrical stun gun, tear gas weapon, mace,  
16 tear gas, pepper mace or any similar deleterious agent against  
17 another person knowing the other person to be a peace officer,  
18 corrections officer, probation or parole officer, firefighter, or an  
19 emergency medical technician or paramedic who is acting in the  
20 course of official duty. Any person violating the provisions of  
21 this section, upon conviction, shall be guilty of a felony  
22 punishable by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of  
23 Corrections for a term not more than two (2) years, or by a fine in  
24 an amount not exceeding One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both  
25 such fine and imprisonment.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

2 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
3 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
4 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
5 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
