**Senate Bill No. 1828**

SENATE BILL NO. 1828 - By: EASON McINTYRE of the Senate and SHUMATE of the House.

An Act relating to schools; directing State Superintendent of Public Instruction to appoint committee to study certain fund expenditure issue; specifying representation from certain school districts; requiring submission of report by certain deadline; providing for noncodification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

The State Superintendent of Public Instruction shall appoint a committee by September 1, 2008, to study and develop a method to determine how districts can report the expenditure of funds generated by the economically disadvantaged weight in the State Aid formula and ensure such funds are expended in support of students identified as economically disadvantaged. The committee shall include representation from each school district with average daily membership greater than ten thousand (10,000). The committee shall submit a report with recommendations to the President Pro Tempore of the State Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the Governor by December 1, 2008.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

1           SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
