Senate Bill No. 1873
As Amended

SENATE BILL NO. 1873 - By: LEFTWICH of the Senate and WESSELHOFT of the House.

[Oklahoma Employment Security Commission - making an appropriation - noncodification - effective date]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

There is hereby appropriated to the Employment Security Administration Fund, out of funds made available to this state by the federal Reed Act Distribution made on March 13, 2002, pursuant to Section 903(d) of the Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C., Section 1103(d), as amended, the amount of Eleven Million Seven Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$11,730,000.00) to be used by the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission for the purpose of paying the administration expenses of the following programs in the following amounts:

- 1. The Employment Service program in the amount of Seven Million Seven Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$7,730,000.00);

1 2. The One-Stop Career Center expenses attributable to the
2 Employment Service and the Unemployment Insurance program in the
3 amount of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00); and

4 3. The Unemployment Insurance program in the amount of Three
5 Million Seven Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,700,000.00).

6 The funds appropriated by this section shall be expended on or
7 before December 31, 2009. Expenditures from this appropriation
8 shall be accounted for in accordance with standards established by
9 the United States Secretary of Labor. The Oklahoma Employment
10 Security Commission shall utilize the appropriation made by this
11 section in accordance with the provisions and requirements contained
12 in the Social Security Act, Title 42, of the United States Code.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
