Senate Bill No. 1887

SENATE BILL NO. 1887 - By: JOHNSON (Constance) of the Senate and
LIEBMANN of the House.

An Act relating to children; permitting certain persons to
inspect specified records without a court order; directing
the Oklahoma Commission on Children and Youth to develop
certain responsibilities and criteria; providing for
codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7307-1.4a of Title 10, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Juvenile court and agency records which are confidential may be
inspected and their contents disclosed without a court order to
employees of a law enforcement agency in the course of official
duties upon showing of proper credentials. The Oklahoma Commission
on Children and Youth shall develop additional responsibilities and
criteria with regard to such inspection and disclosure.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
