Senate Bill No. 1894

SENATE BILL NO. 1894 - By: GARRISON and RABON of the Senate and SHOEMAKE of the House.

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating memorial roads and bridges; requiring placemen of markers; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.18 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge on State Highway 62 south of Haskell, Oklahoma, shall be designated the "Private First Class Cody Montana Carver, U.S. Army 3rd Infantry Division Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the bridge bearing that name.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.19 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The section of State Highway 64 between Muskogee and Keefeton shall be designated the "Representative Jim L. Barker, Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

1 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
