Senate Bill No. 2028
As Amended

SENATE BILL NO. 2028 - By: SYKES of the Senate and JOHNSON (Dennis) of the House.

[guardian and ward - jurisdiction - codification - effective date]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4-904 of Title 30, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any individual who maliciously, forcibly or fraudulently takes or entices away any incapacitated or partially incapacitated person, or any other person over the age of sixteen (16) for whom a guardian has been appointed, with intent to detain and conceal such person from his or her guardian or who transports such person from the jurisdiction of this state or the United States without consent of the guardian or the court shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment not to exceed ten (10) years.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
