5 SENATE BILL NO. 485 - By: LAMB of the Senate and ENNS of the House.

6 [state government - Commission for Rehabilitation Services
7 - incentive program - effective date]

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

9 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 166.8, is
10 amended to read as follows:

11 Section 166.8 A. The Commission for Rehabilitation Services is
12 hereby authorized to:

13 1. Establish an employee performance recognition program that
14 recognizes outstanding job performance and productivity within the
15 State Department of Rehabilitation Services; and

16 2. Expend monies available from the Department's operating
17 funds to purchase recognition awards for presentation to employees
18 with exceptional job performance records, or who make other
19 significant contributions to the operation of the Department.

20 ~~B.~~ Awards to recognize employee achievement pursuant to this
21 subsection may consist of wearing apparel, service pins, plaques,
22 writing pens, or other items valued at not more than One Hundred
23 Dollars (\$100.00) per award.

1 B. Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the Commission
2 for Rehabilitation Services is authorized to use receipt of funds
3 from the Social Security reimbursement program for a direct service
4 delivery staff incentive program. Incentives may be awarded if case
5 service costs are reimbursed for job placement of Social Security or
6 Supplemental Security Income recipients at the Substantial Gainful
7 Activity (SGA) level for nine (9) months pursuant to 42 U.S.C.,
8 Section 422, and under those conditions and criteria as are
9 established by the federal reimbursement program.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2007.
