6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to sunset; amending 59 O.S. 2001,
8 Section 1004, as last amended by Section 52, Chapter
9 3, O.S.L. 2003 (59 O.S. Supp. 2007, Section 1004),
10 which relates to the Oklahoma State Committee of
11 Plumbing Examiners; re-creating the Committee; and
12 modifying termination date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2001, Section 1004, as
15 last amended by Section 52, Chapter 3, O.S.L. 2003 (59 O.S. Supp.
16 2007, Section 1004), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 1004. A. The Oklahoma State Committee of Plumbing
18 Examiners is hereby re-created to continue until ~~July 1, 2008~~
19 _____, in accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma Sunset
20 Law, as provided by Sections 3901 et seq. of Title 74 of the
21 Oklahoma Statutes, and shall consist of five (5) members, each of
22 whom shall be a citizen of the United States, a resident of this
23 state. One member shall be appointed from each congressional
24 district and any remaining members shall be appointed from the state
at large. However, when congressional districts are redrawn each

1 member appointed prior to July 1 of the year in which such
2 modification becomes effective shall complete the current term of
3 office and appointments made after July 1 of the year in which such
4 modification becomes effective shall be based on the redrawn
5 districts. Appointments made after July 1 of the year in which such
6 modification becomes effective shall be from any redrawn districts
7 which are not represented by a board member until such time as each
8 of the modified congressional districts are represented by a board
9 member. No appointments may be made after July 1 of the year in
10 which such modification becomes effective if such appointment would
11 result in more than two members serving from the same modified
12 district. Beginning January 1, 2002, as the terms of members
13 serving on the Committee on such date expire, members of the
14 Committee shall be appointed by the Construction Industries Board
15 which may also remove them for cause. They will hold office for
16 terms of two (2) years, or until their successors are appointed.
17 Two members of the Committee shall have had at least five (5) years'
18 practical experience as a licensed master plumber or plumbing
19 contractor, and two members shall have had at least five (5) years'
20 practical experience as a licensed journeyman plumber. One member
21 shall be a plumbing inspector selected from lists of names submitted
22 from plumbing inspection industries. Whenever appointments of
23 initial, new, or replacement plumbing members of the Committee are

1 to be made, the Board shall choose them only from lists of at least
2 three names to be furnished whenever needed as follows:

3 1. Master plumber or plumbing contractor member - lists to be
4 furnished by associated plumbing and heating contractors of this
5 state;

6 2. Journeyman plumber member - lists to be furnished by state
7 pipe trades associations;

8 3. One licensed master plumber or plumbing contractor who is
9 not a member of an association of plumbing, heating, and cooling
10 contractors of this state; and

11 4. One licensed journeyman plumber who is not a member of a
12 state pipe trades association.

13 B. Duties of the Committee shall be to serve the Construction
14 Industries Board in an advisory capacity, to formulate rules
15 pursuant to The Plumbing License Law of 1955, and to assist and
16 advise the Board on the examination of applicants for licenses as
17 journeyman plumber or plumbing contractor, in accordance with such
18 rules and the terms and conditions hereof. A majority of the
19 Committee shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

20 C. Each examiner shall be reimbursed for travel expenses in
21 accordance with the provisions of the State Travel Reimbursement
22 Act, Section 500.1 et seq. of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
