6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S.
8 2001, Section 4258, as amended by Section 3, Chapter
9 320, O.S.L. 2004 (74 O.S. Supp. 2007, Section 4258),
10 which relates to the Ethics Commission Fund;
11 providing funding based on contributions reported to
12 the Ethics Commission; and providing an effective
13 date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 4258, as
16 amended by Section 3, Chapter 320, O.S.L. 2004 (74 O.S. Supp. 2007,
17 Section 4258), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 4258. A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury
19 a revolving fund for the Ethics Commission to be designated the
20 "Ethics Commission Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not
21 subject to fiscal year limitations and shall consist of all copying
22 fees, lobbyist registration fees, and committee registration fees
23 received by the Commission. All monies accruing to the credit of
24 the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by
the Commission for any expenses incurred in the implementation of

1 this act. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants
2 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
3 law with the Director of State Finance for approval and payment.

4 B. The Ethics Commission shall be fully funded to allow it to
5 enforce the Ethics Commission Rules. The Legislature shall fund the
6 Ethics Commission not less than two percent (2%) of the total
7 contributions reported to the Ethics Commission during the previous
8 two (2) calendar years.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
