6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to soldiers and sailors; prohibiting
8 the pretense of veteran status in order to receive
9 benefits; making impersonation a felony; providing
10 for codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-4 of Title 72, unless there is
15 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 Any person who knowingly, with intent to impersonate and with
17 intent to deceive, poses as a veteran in order to receive or qualify
18 for state benefits offered to veterans shall be guilty of a felony.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
