9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to revenue and taxation; amending  
11 Section 16, Chapter 44, 2nd Extraordinary Session,  
12 O.S.L. 2006 (68 O.S. Supp. 2007, Section 50016),  
13 which relates to master capital improvement plans;  
14 modifying certain reporting methods; and providing an  
15 effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 16, Chapter 44, 2nd  
18 Extraordinary Session, O.S.L. 2006 (68 O.S. Supp. 2007, Section  
19 50016), is amended to read as follows:

20 Section 50016. The ~~Department of~~ Oklahoma Tourism and  
21 Recreation Department shall develop, periodically revise and  
22 maintain a comprehensive state master capital improvement plan for  
23 state park and recreation facilities under its jurisdiction, and  
24 shall prioritize projects within the plan. Prior to the expenditure  
of funds in the Oklahoma Tourism Capital Improvement Revolving Fund,

1 the Department shall identify and list the specific projects for  
2 which such funds will be used, which shall be taken from the state  
3 master plan in the order of priority. If the Department determines  
4 that an emergency exists which could adversely affect the public  
5 peace, health and safety, it may identify and list a project not  
6 taken from the state master plan in the order of priority. In such  
7 instance, the Department shall include a determination of the  
8 existence of such emergency and a justification therefor.

9 The list of such projects shall be submitted, in either printed  
10 or electronic form, to the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma  
11 State Senate and the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of  
12 Representatives. The Legislature may, within thirty (30)  
13 legislative days after submission of the list, in a bill or joint  
14 resolution approved by a vote of not fewer than two-thirds (2/3) of  
15 the members in each house thereof, disapprove one or more projects  
16 on the list and direct the Department to revise and resubmit the  
17 list as provided herein.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 2008.
