5 AS INTRODUCED

6 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and
7 Centennial Commission; amending Section 1, Chapter
8 244, O.S.L. 2007 (73 O.S. Supp. 2007, Section 98.7),
9 which relates to financial reporting; requiring the
10 Oklahoma Department of Commerce to submit a report by
11 a certain date; providing an effective date; and
12 declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 244, O.S.L.
15 2007 (73 O.S. Supp. 2007, Section 98.7), is amended to read as
16 follows:

17 Section 98.7 A. The Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
18 Commemoration Commission shall submit a financial report of the
19 activities of the Commission to the Governor, the Speaker of the
20 House of Representatives, and the President Pro Tempore of the
21 Senate by March 31, 2008. The financial report shall include a
22 summary and accounting of all centennial projects and activities
23 funded by the Commission, the final budget for the Commission, a
24 list of any outstanding or anticipated obligations, and the

1 anticipated balance of any monies remaining after July 1, 2008, in
2 any funds designated for the Commission.

3 B. Upon termination of the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and
4 Centennial Commemoration Commission on July 1, 2008, any remaining
5 rights and responsibilities of the Commission, including the rights
6 and responsibilities of the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
7 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
8 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be transferred to the
9 Oklahoma Department of Commerce. The transfer shall include all
10 property, furniture, equipment, supplies, records, current and
11 future liabilities, fund balances, encumbrances, obligations, and
12 indebtedness associated with the Commission on July 1, 2008.

13 C. The Oklahoma Department of Commerce shall submit a report to
14 the Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the
15 President Pro Tempore of the Senate, either in electronic or written
16 form, of outstanding activities and duties transferred by the
17 Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission, by
18 October 1, 2008. The report shall include a summary and accounting
19 of all property, monies, and obligations transferred by the
20 Commission upon the Commission's termination.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

22 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
23 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
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1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
