10 AS INTRODUCED

11 An Act relating to the State Election Board; making
12 appropriations; stating purposes; requiring budgeting
13 in certain categories and amounts; providing for
14 duties and compensation of employees; limiting the
15 salary of the Secretary; making certain
16 appropriations nonfiscal; providing an effective
17 date; and declaring an emergency.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Election
20 Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General
21 Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June
22 30, 2009, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof
23 as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State
24 Election Board by law.

25 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the State Election
26 Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special

1 Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of _____ Dollars
2 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be required to pay the necessary
3 expenses of holding elections.

4 SECTION 3. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the State
5 Election Board shall budget all funds in the following categories
6 and amounts:

13 SECTION 4. The duties and compensation of employees, not
14 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
15 upon the State Election Board by law shall be set by the State
16 Election Board. The salary of the Secretary of the State Election
17 Board shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per
18 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009.
19 The State Election Board for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009,
20 shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-
21 time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures
22 for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized
23 pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the
24 Oklahoma Statutes:

4 SECTION 5. The appropriation made by this act shall not be
5 subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for
6 encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30)
7 months from the date this act is approved.

8 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

9 SECTION 7. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
