10 AS INTRODUCED

11 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Arts Council; making
12 an appropriation; stating purpose; providing for the
13 budgeting of funds in certain categories and amounts;
14 requiring certain performance measures for budget
15 categories; providing for duties and compensation of
16 employees of the Oklahoma Arts Council; limiting the
17 maximum salary of the Chief Administrative Officer;
18 providing budgetary limitations; requiring budgeting
19 of certain funds in certain years; requiring certain
20 budget procedures; prohibiting certain budget
21 procedures; providing lapse dates; providing an
22 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

24 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Arts
Council from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General

1 Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June
2 30, 2009, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the
4 Oklahoma Arts Council by law.

5 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
6 Oklahoma Arts Council shall budget all funds in the following
7 categories and amounts:

13 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
14 each budget category.

15 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
16 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
17 upon the Oklahoma Arts Council by law shall be set by the Council.
18 The salary of the Chief Administrative Officer shall not exceed
19 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the
20 fiscal year ending June 30, 2009. The Oklahoma Arts Council for the
21 fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the following
22 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees, except as
23 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
24 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

3 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including
4 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
5 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 (hereafter FY-09) or may be
6 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10).
7 Funds budgeted for FY-09 may be encumbered only through June 30,
8 2009, and must be expended by November 15, 2009. Any funds
9 remaining after November 15, 2009, and not budgeted for FY-10, shall
10 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
11 year. Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June
12 30, 2010. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2010, shall lapse
13 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
14 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
15 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-09, and not required to pay
16 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-10, after
17 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
18 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
19 from the FY-09 budget work program and after such revision has been
20 approved by the Office of State Finance.

21 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

22 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
23 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
24

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
