9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Board of Medicolegal
11 Investigations; making an appropriation; stating
12 purpose; requiring budgeting in certain categories
13 and amounts; requiring performance measures;
14 providing for the duties and compensation of
15 employees; limiting salary of the Chief Medical
16 Examiner; providing budgetary limitations; making
17 certain full-time-equivalent employees contingent
18 upon certain funding; providing lapse dates;
19 requiring and prohibiting certain budget practices;
20 providing an effective date; and declaring an
21 emergency.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Board of
24 Medicolegal Investigations from any monies not otherwise
appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for
the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the sum of _____
Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform

1 the duties imposed upon the Board of Medicolegal Investigations by
2 law.

3 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the Board
4 of Medicolegal Investigations shall budget all funds in the
5 following categories and amounts:

10 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
11 each budget category.

12 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
13 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
14 upon the Board of Medicolegal Investigations by law shall be set by
15 the Board. The salary of the Chief Medical Examiner shall not
16 exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for
17 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009. The Board of Medicolegal
18 Investigations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, shall be
19 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-
20 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for
21 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant
22 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
23 Statutes:

3 SECTION 4. Of the total number of full-time-equivalent
4 employees authorized for the Board of Medicolegal Investigations,
5 two shall be employed contingent upon sufficient federal grant
6 funding to support them.

7 SECTION 5. Appropriations made by this act, not including
8 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
9 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 (hereafter FY-09) or may be
10 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10).
11 Funds budgeted for FY-09 may be encumbered only through June 30,
12 2009, and must be expended by November 15, 2009. Any funds
13 remaining after November 15, 2009, and not budgeted for FY-10, shall
14 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
15 year. Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June
16 30, 2010. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2010, shall lapse
17 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
18 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
19 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-09, and not required to pay
20 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-10, after
21 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
22 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
23 from the FY-09 budget work program and after such revision has been
24 approved by the Office of State Finance.

1 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

2 SECTION 7. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
3 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
4 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
5 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
