10 AS INTRODUCED

11 An Act relating to the Department of Mines; making an
12 appropriation; stating purpose; requiring budgeting
13 in certain categories and amounts; providing for
14 duties and compensation of employees; limiting the
15 salary of the Executive Director; providing budgetary
16 limitations; making certain appropriations nonfiscal;
17 providing lapse dates; requiring certain budget
18 procedures; prohibiting certain budget procedures;
19 providing an effective date; and declaring an
20 emergency.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 DEPARTMENT OF MINES

23 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of
24 Mines from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General
Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June
30, 2009, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Department
2 of Mines by law.

3 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the
4 Department of Mines shall budget all funds in the following
5 categories and amounts:

12 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
13 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
14 upon the Department of Mines by law shall be set by the Executive
15 Director of the Department of Mines. The salary of the Executive
16 Director of the Department of Mines shall not exceed _____
17 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year
18 ending June 30, 2009. The Department of Mines for the fiscal year
19 ending June 30, 2009, shall be subject to the following budgetary
20 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures
21 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as
22 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
23 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

3 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including
4 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
5 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 (hereafter FY-09) or may be
6 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10).
7 Funds budgeted for FY-09 may be encumbered only through June 30,
8 2009, and must be expended by November 15, 2009. Any funds
9 remaining after November 15, 2009, and not budgeted for FY-10, shall
10 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
11 year. Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June
12 30, 2010. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2010, shall lapse
13 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
14 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
15 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-09, and not required to pay
16 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-10, after
17 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
18 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
19 from the FY-09 budget work program and after such revision has been
20 approved by the Office of State Finance.

21 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2008.

22 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
23 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
24

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
