6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to driver licenses; amending 47 O.S.  
8 2001, Section 6-112, as amended by Section 8, Chapter  
9 326, O.S.L. 2007 (47 O.S. Supp. 2007, Section 6-112),  
10 which relates to possessing and displaying driver  
licenses; modifying penalty; providing exception to  
prohibited act; modifying procedure for dismissal of  
charges; and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2001, Section 6-112, as  
15 amended by Section 8, Chapter 326, O.S.L. 2007 (47 O.S. Supp. 2007,  
16 Section 6-112), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 6-112. A. Every licensee shall have his or her driver  
18 license in his or her immediate possession at all times when  
19 operating a motor vehicle and shall display the same upon demand of  
20 a peace officer.

21 B. Any person violating this ~~subsection~~ section shall, upon  
22 conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished ~~as~~  
23 ~~provided for in Section 17-101 of this title~~ by a fine of not less  
24 than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars

1 (\$500.00). However, no person shall be charged with violating the  
2 provisions of this section if, upon demand of a peace officer, the  
3 person produces an alternate form of identification in lieu of his  
4 or her driver license.

5 ~~B.~~ C. Any person charged with violating this section who  
6 produces in court or to the law enforcement agency of the arresting  
7 peace officer, on or before the court date, a driver license issued  
8 to him or her and valid at the time of his or her arrest shall be  
9 entitled to dismissal of such charge without payment of court costs  
10 and fine.

11 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
12 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
