6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to cities and towns; amending 11 O.S.
8 2001, Section 10-112, as amended by Section 1,
9 Chapter 386, O.S.L. 2005 (11 O.S. Supp. 2007, Section
10 10-112), which relates to the appointment of city
11 manager; modifying term of appointment; and providing
12 an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2001, Section 10-112, as
15 amended by Section 1, Chapter 386, O.S.L. 2005 (11 O.S. Supp. 2007,
16 Section 10-112), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 10-112. The council shall appoint a city manager ~~for an~~
18 ~~indefinite term~~ by a vote of a majority of all its members, subject
19 to the terms of employment established by the council. It shall
20 choose the city manager solely on the basis of executive and
21 administrative qualifications with special reference to the actual
22 experience in, or the knowledge of, accepted practice in respect to
23 the duties of the office. ~~At the time of appointment, the city~~
24 ~~manager need not be a resident of the city or state; but during the~~
~~tenure of holding office the city manager shall reside within the~~

1 ~~city.~~ City managers may appoint themselves, or the council or other
2 authority may appoint or elect the city manager, to other offices
3 and positions in the city government, subject to regulations
4 prescribed by ordinance; but the city manager may not receive
5 compensation for service in such other offices or positions.
6 Neither the mayor nor any members of the city council may be
7 appointed city manager during the term for which they shall have
8 been elected nor within two (2) years after they cease to hold such
9 office.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective September 1, 2008.
