6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to higher education; stating
8 legislative intent that the Oklahoma State Regents
9 for Higher Education adopt a certain policy on
10 residency for dependents of certain federal
11 government employees; providing for noncodification;
12 and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
15 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

16 It is the intent of the Legislature that the Oklahoma State
17 Regents for Higher Education review its state residency policies for
18 tuition and fees, scholarship, and financial aid purposes and adopt
19 a policy that allows the dependents of employees of the federal
20 government who are transferred out-of-state but have retained
21 Oklahoma residency to be charged resident tuition and have the
22 opportunity to participate in all state scholarship and financial
23 aid programs as residents.

1 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
