6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to motor vehicles; directing  
8 Department of Public Safety to provide notification  
9 of certain event; providing guidelines for mailing  
10 notices; authorizing promulgation of rules; providing  
11 for codification; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-115.3 of Title 47, unless  
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. The Department of Public Safety shall notify, in writing,  
17 every person that has been issued a driver license in this state  
18 when such driver license is due to expire. Notification shall be  
19 mailed to the person at least sixty (60) days prior to the  
20 expiration date of the driver license. Such notices shall be sent  
21 by first-class, postage-prepaid mail to the last-known address of  
22 the person.

23 B. The Department shall promulgate rules necessary to implement  
24 and administer the provisions of this act.
