6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to consumer credit; requiring credit
8 reporting agencies to have an office and agent
9 present in the state for the settlement of credit
10 disputes; providing for codification; and providing
11 an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-207 of Title 14A, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 All national credit reporting agencies shall have an office and
17 an agent physically located in this state. Credit reporting
18 agencies shall provide consumers in this state an opportunity to
19 mitigate, argue, dispute, or settle credit problems or errors in
20 person.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
