6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to handicapped parking; amending 11
8 O.S. 2001, Section 36-101A, which relates to
9 handicapped parking and access; requiring certain
10 language be displayed with disabled parking signs;
11 providing for effect on other laws; and providing an
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2001, Section 36-101A, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 36-101A. A. Cities and towns are hereby authorized to
17 construct and provide parking spaces, curb cuts, ramps and signage
18 for handicapped parking and access for use in conjunction with
19 facilities, both public and private, open to the general public.
20 The city or town may bear the cost of such construction, or at the
21 option of the city or town and the owner of such facilities, share
22 the cost of such construction with the owner of such facilities.

23 B. Beginning January 1, 2009, the posted signage for every
24 parking space that is designated and posted as a reserved area for
the parking of a motor vehicle operated by or transporting a

1 physically disabled person shall include the language "RESERVED
2 PARKING". The provisions of this section shall be considered an
3 addition to any federal or state law, rule, or regulation regarding
4 the signage requirements for handicapped or physically disabled
5 parking spaces and shall not limit or amend any other applicable
6 laws, rules, or regulations.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2009.
