7 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; making
8 certain acts unlawful; providing penalty; providing
for codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1960 of Title 21, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. It shall be unlawful for any sex offender, who is required
16 by law to register pursuant to the Sex Offenders Registration Act,
17 to access or use any Internet social networking web site that has
18 the potential or likelihood of allowing the sex offender to have
19 contact with any child who is under the age of eighteen (18) years.

20 B. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall,
21 upon conviction, be guilty of a felony.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2008.
