6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to labor; amending 40 O.S. 2001,
8 Section 1-224, as last amended by Section 2, Chapter
9 354, O.S.L. 2007 (40 O.S. Supp. 2007, Section 1-224),
10 which relates to the Employment Security Act of 1980;
11 requiring Commission to implement certain electronic
12 filing procedures; and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 40 O.S. 2001, Section 1-224, as
14 last amended by Section 2, Chapter 354, O.S.L. 2007 (40 O.S. Supp.
15 2007, Section 1-224), is amended to read as follows:

16 Section 1-224. FILE.

17 A. When any document is required to be filed by the provisions
18 of the Employment Security Act of 1980 or the rules promulgated
19 under the authority of the Employment Security Act of 1980 with the
20 Oklahoma Employment Security Commission, any of its representatives,
21 or the Board of Review for the Oklahoma Employment Security
22 Commission, the term "file", "files", or "filed" shall be defined as
23 follows:

1 1. Hand-delivered to an office of the Oklahoma Employment
2 Security Commission by the close of business on or before the date
3 due;

4 2. Telefaxed to an office of the Oklahoma Employment Security
5 Commission by midnight on or before the date due. Timely telefaxing
6 shall be determined by the date and time printed by the Commission's
7 telefax machine on the document received or the date and time on the
8 sender's transmittal sheet;

9 3. Mailed with sufficient postage and properly addressed to an
10 office of the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission on or before
11 the date due. Timely mailing shall be determined by the postmark;
12 or

13 4. Electronically transmitted via data lines to the Commission
14 by midnight on or before the date due. Timely transmission shall be
15 determined by the Commission's transmission log file.

16 B. The Commission shall, by December 31, 2008, implement the
17 necessary procedures and software to accept electronic filings of
18 employee contributions as outlined by Section 3-102 of this title.

19 C. If the Employment Security Act of 1980 or the rules
20 promulgated under the Employment Security Act of 1980 require that a
21 document be filed with a court or any other agency of this state,
22 the term "file", "files" or "filed" shall be defined by the
23 statutes, rules or practice governing that court or agency.
